

VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WAKEMAN, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO.: 2021-O-12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2021 ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Wakeman Village Council previously passed Ordinance No.: 2021-O-2 titled Annual Appropriation Ordinance setting the annual appropriations for the year and providing for the current expenses and other expenditures of the village; and

WHEREAS, RC 5705.38(A) provides that during the year the taxing authority of the subdivision may pass any supplemental appropriation measures as it finds necessary; and

WHEREAS, RC 5705.40 provides that any appropriation ordinance or measure may be amended or supplemented; and

WHEREAS, an ordinance by village council is necessary when the appropriation amendment will result in a reallocation of the line item amounts approved in the village's permanent appropriation ordinance [See Village Officer's Handbook, March 2019, Chapter Six: Accounting Procedures, Section IX Amending Appropriations. (Page 6-12); and

WHEREAS, the Village Fiscal Officer advises that it is necessary to amend the 2021 Annual Appropriation Ordinance to appropriate additional unappropriated monies to the 2901 - CITIZENS DONATION FUND due to: "to utilize monies pursuant to law, and to assure proper accounting and balances."

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAKEMAN, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That the Annual Appropriation Ordinance 2021-O-2 be amended providing for the appropriation of unappropriated monies as follows:

- A. 2901 - CITIZENS DONATION FUND in amount of \$15,000.00 to line item 2901-310-600-4942.

SECTION 2. That the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to obtain an amended certificate of funds from the County Auditor to reflect the additional appropriations, and the amended appropriations amended herein shall not be effective until receipt.

SECTION 3. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. R.C. 731.17(A)(2) That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days.

SECTION 4. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s): *The immediate effectiveness of this ordinance is necessary to utilize monies pursuant to law, and to assure proper accounting and balances.*

SECTION 5. PUBLIC MEETING. It is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.






