RESOLUTION NO.: 2021-R-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HURON COUNTY SHERIFF FOR THE RENEWAL OF DISPATCHING SERVICES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village desires to have quality dispatching service for its police department; and

WHEREAS, the Village currently contracts with the Huron County Sheriff to provide dispatching services to the Police Department which is scheduled to expire June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Huron County Sheriff has submitted a proposed contract renewal, a copy of which is ATTACHED HERETO and expressly incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police remains satisfied with the dispatching services of the Huron County Sheriff and recommends the renewal of the Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAKEMAN, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Village Council hereby finds and determines that it is necessary to continue to obtain dispatching services for the Police Department from the Huron County Sheriff.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement renewing the dispatching services provided by the Huron County Sheriff to the Police Department pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in the contract. **SEE COPY ATTACHED HERETO** and expressly incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days. (R.C. 705.15 and 731.17(A)(2))

SECTION 4. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance/Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s): *The current agreement will expire 6/30/2021.*

SECTION 5. PUBLIC MEETING. That it is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any



applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance/Resolution shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.

The contract between your department and the Huron County Sheriff's Office for dispatching services for the July 2021 – June 2022 year is attached. You will notice a slight monthly increase to your current fees for the upcoming contract year. This increase will help us offset some of the costs associated with equipment upgrades, union raises, and mandatory training for our 9 dispatchers.

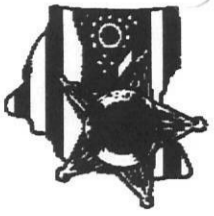

WAKEMAN POLICE DEPARTMENT DISPATCHING CONTRACT

This agreement is entered into by and between the Village of Wakeman, Ohio and the Huron County Sheriff's Office of Norwalk, Ohio on this 14 day of June, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Village of Wakeman desires to have a quality dispatching service for its police department, and

WHEREAS, the Huron County Sheriff's Office will satisfactorily furnish dispatching service for the Village of Wakeman, for an extended period of time,

it is therefore agreed between the parties that:

1. Huron County Sheriff's Office will furnish all labor for the operation of a 24 hours a day, 365 days per year, monitoring and dispatching service on both the radio and telephone for the Village of Wakeman and its police department.
2. The Village of Wakeman shall supply the phone lines and pay the rental on said phone lines to the Huron County Sheriff's Office.
3. The Village of Wakeman shall pay to the Huron County Sheriff's Office the sum of \$5,640.00 payable \$470.00 per month, for the above service.
4. This contract shall remain in effect from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.

Either party may terminate this contract before its expiration with no less than thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other party. Payment for dispatch service shall be prorated to date of termination.
