

VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WAKEMAN, OHIO
ORDINANCE NO. 2022-O-17

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO EXPEND MONEY FROM THE WATER RESERVE REPLACEMENT FUND TO PAY FOR CERTAIN REPAIRS, MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE VILLAGE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village provides and regulates a supply of water, and provides for the management and control of water works for the protection of such water supply. (See ORC 715.08 and 743.02 et seq.) (See also Chapter 921 of the Wakeman Codified Municipal Code of Ordinances); and

WHEREAS, the village previously established and currently maintains a Water Reserve Replacement Fund to be utilized for emergency repairs and capital improvements to the Village water distribution system; and

WHEREAS, Council has agreed to move forward with allowing the Village Administrator to prepare and submit an application to participate in the Ohio Public Works (OPWC), State Capital Improvement Program (SCIP) for the Farmer Street/Cooper Ex & West Abbott St. Waterline Replacement Project ; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer reports that there are insufficient funds in the Water Fund (Water System Operating Fund) to pay the local share for the Farmer Street/ Cooper Ex & West Abbott St Waterline Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer requests authorization to expend money from the Water Reserve Replacement Fund to pay for the necessary repair, maintenance and improvements to include paying the Village's local share.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WAKEMAN, STATE OF OHIO: (RC 731.18)

SECTION 1. That Council hereby finds and determines that it is necessary to and improvements to include the Farmer/Cooper Ext. & West Abbott St. Water Line Replacement.

SECTION 2. That Council further finds and determines that there are insufficient funds in the Water Fund (Water System Operating Fund) for Farmer/Cooper Ext & West Abbott St Waterline Replacement and that it is necessary to expend funds from the Water Reserve Replacement Fund.

SECTION 3. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and directed to expend funds not to exceed **Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00)** from the Water Reserve Replacement Fund for the purpose of repairs, maintenance and improvements for the Farmer/Cooper ex. & West Abbott St Waterline Replacement Project as part of the Village water distribution system.

SECTION 4. DISPENSE WITH THREE READINGS. [R.C. 731.17(A)(2)] That the legislative authority, upon a vote of at least three-fourths of its members, hereby dispenses with the rule requiring each ordinance or resolution shall be read on three different days.

SECTION 5. DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT. That by two-thirds vote of all the members elected to the legislative authority, this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure pursuant to RC 731.30, being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the municipal corporation and shall go into immediate effect for the following reason(s): *For the preservation and ongoing efficient operations of the village water distribution system.*

SECTION 6. PUBLIC MEETING. It is found and determined that all formal action of this public body concerning or relating to the passage of this Resolution/Ordinance were adopted in a public meeting open to the public at all times, and that all deliberations of the public body and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in public meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including all lawful ordinances and any applicable provisions of section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this legislation shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
